All pupils in Primary 1, Primary 1 / 2, Primary 2 and Primary 3 are due to return to school on **Monday 8**<sup>th</sup> **March**. For St Brigid's that will be 109 children, plus Key Worker Children. Therefore, there we will return to staggered drop-off and collection times:

**Surname M – O** 09.05

**Surname P – Y** 09.15



You must follow social distancing rules and wear a mask, you should not linger or loiter at the school gates.

- Ensure anyone with COVID-19 symptoms does not attend school
- Wash hands thoroughly and more often than usual to prepare your child for returning to school
- Promote respiratory hygiene using the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' approach
- Minimise contact and maintain social distancing when possible stay in your family bubble, no playdates or meeting up with others (even outdoors).

The health of children and adults who are immune-suppressed depends on you not sending your child into school if they are unwell. Please be wary and kind.

School meals cost £2.60 and this must be put in an envelope with the child's name, paid daily. Staff cannot accept payment for a week in advance, nor can they provide change.

Our Easter Vacation is from **Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> April – Friday 9<sup>th</sup> April** inclusive. Term 3 begins on **Monday 12<sup>th</sup> April**.

The school photographer, C S Moments, is scheduled to be in school (Coronavirus restrictions permitting) on **Monday 12**<sup>th</sup> **and Tuesday 13**<sup>th</sup> **April**. It is planned that only individual photographs will be taken, however, if you wish your children to have a family photograph taken, please telephone the school office by Friday 26<sup>th</sup> March so that this can be arranged.
